The Rio Grande Compact was signed in 1938 as a legal agreement between Colorado, New Mexico, and Texas that outlines how the water of the Rio Grande will be shared equitably among them.

This tour, hosted by the Rio Grande Basin Roundtable, will begin at the Closed Basin Project in Alamosa and end at the Lobatos Bridge, stopping at significant Rio Grande Compact sites in Colorado along the way.
